*As I'm sure you are aware of the current political climate around Bill 96, I wanted to forward some important information from WQSB's Parent Committee.*

*The English Parent's Committee Association of Quebec along with other Anglophone advocacy groups are organizing a Rally to take place on May 14th 2022 in Montreal to protest the Bill.*

If you are interested in participating, please see the relevant details below.

- Rally participants will **meet at Dawson College** (3040 Rue Sherbrooke O, Westmount, Quebec H3Z 1A4), **at 10:30a.m on May 14th, 2022.**
  - From there, participants will march to Premier François Legault's office where community leaders will speak to the impact Bill 96 will have on the Anglophone community in Quebec.

WQSB PC/EPCA proposes two options for getting to Montreal.

1. If you want to drive yourself, a 50\$ stipend will be offered to the first 20 drivers/ vehicles that submit their interest and participate in the event.
2. For those who would wish to have an alternative means of transportation, a school bus will be chartered for WQSB parents. The bus will leave the WQSB Office, 15 Rue Katimavik, Gatineau, Quebec J9J 0E9, on May 14th at 7:30a.m. and will return around 3:30p.m. on the same day.

**Note that free parking will be available at the WQSB office.**

***Both options are limited in terms of availability/capacity, and therefore the rule of first come first served will apply.***
