

ENTOURAGE PROJECT

Entourage aims to prevent sexual exploitation by promoting the development of critical thinking and empowerment.

This project targets people aged 12 to 25 years old across Quebec. The Workshops are 75 to 90 minutes and are free either in French or in English.

GENDER REPRESENTATIONS AND DYNAMICS

The workshop allows the participants to address gender stereotypes, particularly the digital gender representation on social media, in pornography, as well in the traditional media. Therefore, participants will be able to identify the impact of these stereotypes on their interpersonal and intimate relationships.

SEXUAL CONSENT

This workshop allows the participants to understand the legal aspects of sexual consent, as well as its application. Whether it is in real life or online, they will have the tools to assess their consent and to also manage rejection without violence.

EQUAL RELATIONSHIPS AND VIOLENCE

This workshop discusses the importance of intimate equal relationships. It leads participants to have a reflection on the characteristics of violence free relationships in order to develop their capacity to assess their needs and limits.

EMPOWERMENT IN INTIMATE CONTEXT

With this workshop, participants will be able to distinguish sex work from sexual exploitation. They will also be able to understand the sexual exploitation cycle in order to recognise the warning signs.
