Topics Covered:

• The importance of taking responsibility and staying safe at home

- How to prepare for and respond to unexpected situations (strangers, surprise visitors)
- Basic first aid techniques

Required Materials:

- Pencils and colored pencils, including a highlighter
- Δ marker
- Their manual (will be given at school or sent by mail)
